Some issues have emerged as the work has progressed, but these have been resolved effectively by the construction company (main contractor is Owen Pell) in liaison with the Council's planning officers.</li> <li>The next phase of the project will include drainage works, then fencing and lighting. The contractor programme is scheduled to finish in July, with the track set to open in August.</li> <li>The project team continues to meet monthly.</li> <li>The project is currently on track in terms of budget and timescales.</li> <li>The project team remain focused on delivering a project that will offer</li> </ul>
